Rules for the Youth Leades Tournament

1. This tournament is a USBC Certified Youth Tournament and is open to all SNUSBCA certified bowlers. It will be held on Sat August 18th, 2007 at the Texas Station Bowling Center beginning at 9:00 a.m. Bowlers are requested to check in at least one hour prior to the start time for their lane assignment. Entries will be accepted the day of the tournament, but will close once competition begins.

Note: You must present your current USBC Certification card at check in. If you do not have a current card, you will be required to purchase a card prior to your squad time.

2. Participation in this tournament is limited to current 2006-2007 members of the Southern Nevada USBC Association. There will be six divisions.

Handicap is based on 90% of 200.

3. Entering averages shall be determined as below:
- a. 2005-2006 SNUSBCA book average or Junior Gold average, whichever is higher, or
 - b. **Bowlers current league average if higher (winter or summer). Bring a current league standing sheet with you!**
 - c. **Bowlers without an average will have until their scheduled squad time to establish the highest 9 game average from their current league, which must be verified by a league sheet from league coordinator or coach. Bring a current league standing sheet with you!**
 - d. All others will be assigned a 200 average with a 0 handicap

Note: The re-rate rule may apply. (Rule # 319a-c) **It is the bowlers' responsibility to provide the highest average.** Failure to do so may result in disqualification from tournament. Averages are subject to change after verification by the Tournament Director or Tournament Secretary.

5. The Entry Fee will be broken down as follows:

Returned Checks: Any fees and related bank charges must be paid immediately.

Awards and Scholarship Fees and all Late Fees and Excess Funds will be put into the Scholarship Fund.

6. Formats are as follows:

Handicap Divisions: Contestants will bowl 5 games across ten lanes. The top 50% , based on total pin count will advance to the semi- finals. In the event of a tie for fifth place, there will be a 9th & 10th frame roll-off until the tie is broken (with 1/10 of handicap per frame, where applicable), to determine who advances to the semi-finals. Bowlers will then bowl 3 games across 6 lanes. The top 5 bowlers in each division will then bowl in the stepladder finals. In the stepladder finals, the fifth place qualifier will meet the fourth place qualifier in a one-game match with the winner advancing to meet the third place qualifier. This format will continue until the champion has been determined.

Scratch Division: Contestants will bowl 5 games across 10 lanes. The top 50% based on total pin count, will advance to the semi-finals. They will bowl 3 games across 6 lanes, in a head to head match play format. The total pin count, plus 30 bonus points for each game won will determine the final totals. The top 5 will go forward to the stepladder finals, #5 bowls #4, the winner bowls #3, etc.

7. Scholarships will be given for 1st Place in each division. Additional scholarships will be given based on the number of entries in each division. (1:7 ratio) Scholarships will be held in trust by SMART. All scholarship fees will be returned 100% to the bowlers. All scholarship funds will be held by SMART, account number 9815.

****Donations for Scholarships will be accepted at the tournament. Receipts will be available.****

9. Dress Code: All bowlers must wear suitable attire. **All bowlers may wear a shirt imprinted with their name, name of bowling team, league, club or center logo OR a shirt with a collar and sleeves.** Girls shall wear pants, skirts or split skirts/walking shorts. All skirts/walking shorts must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. Apparel made of denim, elastic or spandex type material will not be permitted. Clothes must be clean and in good repair. Parachute pants, warm-up suits or fleece garments are not allowed. Pants can not be sagging or dragging on the floor. No headgear of any kind may be worn. **No bare midriffs when arms are extended above the head will be permitted.** Jeans are allowed but must be clean and in good repair.

Bowlers will not be allowed to check in until properly dressed.

11. Bowlers are not permitted the use of tobacco or alcoholic products during tournament play. Beverages and food are permitted, but must be kept in the area behind the player's section. Offensive language or hand gestures will not be tolerated and offenders may be removed immediately from the event in progress. This will be strictly enforced. Bowlers not ready to bowl when it is their turn will receive zero (0) for every frame missed, unless a tournament official has been notified. **The use of electronic devices, including cell phones, headsets, pagers, etc. will be not be allowed by tournament bowlers during their competition.**

12. All USBC Youth Tournament Rules and Regulations shall apply, except where otherwise specified in these tournament rules. The Tournament Director shall have the power to hear and act on all protests arising from or under construction of the rules of this tournament. The Tournament Director shall decide any and all questions not covered by the rules. Any protests must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Director within 30 minutes of completion of squad in protest.

Only Tournament Bowlers, Officials and Center Staff will be permitted in the Settee Area.

13. Posted Tournament Standings are considered UNOFFICIAL until announced otherwise.
