Closing Date for Reserved Entries will be April 13, 2012. Walk-ins will be accepted 1 hour prior to the squad if space is available .

Tournament Rules and Entry Form

1. All bowlers must have a current USBC card in the state of Nevada for the 2011-2012 season.
2. Handicap will be 90% of the individual average from 220 in each division, except classic singles, which will be scratch.
3. Entrants shall use their highest USBC average as of January 1, 2012, with a minimum of (12) games. If a player does not have a current average they will use their highest verifiable 2011 summer average of 21 games; if they have no average they will have until April 19, 2012 to complete (12) games. All others will bowl scratch (220) if they do not have a verifiable average by April 19, 2012. All bowlers and coaches are responsible for submitting the correct average. If incorrect averages are submitted, bowlers will be rerated to the correct average and placed in the correct division.
4. All entries submitted must have a verifiable average attached. Average verifications must include the bowler's name, average, number of games bowled, and an officials signature. (A copy of a league sheet, Jan. 1st average list or a copy of the average book with an officials signature will be acceptable).
5. Bowlers are not limited to the number of times they may enter the team event, providing there are no more than (2) of the same bowlers on a new team. **THE FIRST TEAM EVENT SERIES IS TO BE COUNTED IN ALL EVENTS.** Pacers will not be allowed. Team event in all divisions may consist of (4) boys, (4) girls or mixed.
6. A bowler may enter the doubles/singles event only once. **If you bowl doubles you must bowl singles.** Bowlers may enter doubles with someone other than their own division. Doubles will be bowled first. Doubles in all divisions may consist of (2) boys, (2) girls or mixed. If one bowler is late for the doubles event, the entrant present will bowl their singles event first. If their partner has not arrived by the time the singles event is finished and a substitute is not available they will be permitted to bowl their games in the doubles event in order to qualify for all events. Substitutes will be allowed to bowl once in doubles.
7. Everyone who bowls team, doubles, and singles will be placed in all events in their respective divisions.
8. **Suitable attire must be worn. Bowlers should wear collared or bowling style shirts. No tank tops, spandex or fleece, no clothing depicting obscene language, gestures, tobacco or alcohol products will be allowed. No sagging pants will be allowed. No head-gear of any kind may be worn. No electronic devises of any kind (cell phones, i-pods etc).** Final determination of proper attire will be at the discretion of the tournament director or their designee.
9. A bowler may be suspended from the tournament for using any tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, using foul language or gestures.
10. **Tardy Players:** Bowlers arriving late will receive no score for the frames missed if not replaced by a substitute. Once a substitute has thrown a ball for score, the sub will complete the event in progress.
11. Bowlers must remain in the settee area during competition. Permission to leave the area must be given by a lane monitor or a tournament official. Food and beverages will be allowed, but must be kept in the area behind the player's lanes.
12. Teams will be in the order they are listed on the entry form. Entries will be given schedule preference based on the distance traveled and in the order the entries were received.
13. **Divisions:** The number of entries will determine the number of divisions. Classic singles and all events will be a scratch division. Each division of team, doubles and singles must have a minimum of (6) entries. In the event that fewer than (6) entries are received, those entries received will be classified in an appropriate division. Singles will have both boy and girl divisions.
14. Results will be posted within 30 days after the completion of the tournament in each bowling center. Until then all results are considered unofficial.
15. **Awards:** Awards will be based on a 1 in 5 ratio of entries in each division. Scholarship awards are based on the number of entries in each division. The tournament committee will determine the scholarship amounts.
- 16.. Any rules not set forth in this entry form will be covered by the general USBC playing rules.
17. Any appeals or protests regarding scores or eligibility must be made in writing to the tournament director within 24 hours after the error or infraction has occurred. The decision of the board will be final, except where an appeal is made in writing within 72 hours to the Youth state board.
