Mike Clemence has had a long and distinguished bowling career, starting as a young man in Detroit, and for the past 18 years, here in Southern Nevada.

His career achievements are impressive. On the national stage, he has won an Eagle as a member of the 1989 ABC Tournament Team Event champions in Wichita, Kansas. He followed that up the very next year in Reno by shooting a 300 game in the ABC Tournament.

Since moving to Las Vegas in 1992, he has consistently been one of the best players in town, shooting too many honor scores to list. He has won many tournament titles in our area including 3 WCST (West Coast Senior Tour) titles in the past year.

He is also among a very small group of people who have been part of a 600 game in doubles (which is a USBC National record), shooting it with his son, Chris, in a doubles league at the Suncoast in November 2006.

Mike's high series is a very impressive 877, shot in 2001, and he has averaged over 230 in league on at least 6 occasions with 238.7 as his high average for a season in 2006-07.

In addition to these accomplishments, Mike is very well liked by his fellow bowlers and that makes him an excellent choice for induction into the SNUSBCA Hall of Fame.
