1. The Tournament Committee will decide all disputes. The decision of the tournament committee shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
2. Eligibility: This event is open to State of Nevada High School bowlers who represent their specific high school during the 2023-2024 bowling season. The Coach of the High School/Club will select competitors and will set their own criteria for selection. With the exception noted below, each High School/Club may send not more than two (2) male and two (2) female competitors. The Bowling Coach is responsible for completing the entry form and turning it in or mailing it to the address located on page 3 of this form or, you may fax the entry form(s) to (702) 778-2211 by Monday, April 15, 2024. Any member of the current year's NIAA 3A, 4A or 5A State Bowling Championship Team or Singles champion will be eligible to enter and they will not count against the four-bowler limit noted in the preceding paragraph. Use an additional copy of the entry form if the number of bowlers exceeds six.
3. Format: This is a Scratch Only Tournament with two divisions, male and female. Bowlers will be assigned lanes at time of check-in. Check in starts at 8:00 a.m. The qualifying round will begin at 9:00 a.m. Each competitor will bowl four (4) games across eight (8) lanes. The highest total pin fall from the four (4) games of qualifying will determine the top twelve (12) males and top twelve (12) females who will then bowl three games across 6 lanes. Scores will be cumulative for all seven (7) games. After the seven (7) games are completed the top five (5) males and top five (5) females with the highest cumulative totals will bowl a PBA-style stepladder format to determine the champions.
4. Entry Fee: $\$ 15.00$ per person with 2023-2024 USBC card. $\$ 20.00$ per person without a 2023-2024 USBC card. After lineage is paid, any excess will be added to the scholarship donations. All fees must be paid prior to bowling.
5. Prize Fund: Scholarships will be awarded to all finalists (top five (5) males and top five (5) females). In addition, sixth (6 $6^{\text {th }}$ ) place in both divisions will be awarded a $\$ 175.00$ scholarship. If a tie exists for $6^{\text {th }}$ place, each bowler will be awarded with the $\$ 175$. The following shows the distribution of scholarship amounts to be awarded to the stepladder participants:

All scholarships for this tournament will be held in trust with the USBC SMART Program in Arlington, Texas (Account \# 9815). Scholarship money, names of winners and amount of scholarship will be included in mailing to SMART.
6. Equipment: Bowlers must provide their own bowling ball, bag and shoes.
7. Dress Code: Shirts with School/Club Name must be worn. Boys are asked to wear slacks and girls should wear skirts or slacks. Attire must be neat, clean and proper fitting. No hats, No attire advertising liquor or tobacco products or with inappropriate language. Tournament Official decisions are final.
8. Bowlers Area: Only bowlers, high school bowling coaches and tournament officials shall be permitted in the bowling area. No food or drinks will be permitted.
9. Late: A bowler arriving late shall begin play and the score will count, beginning with the frame being bowled. Frames missed shall be credited with a zero. A bowler who is not present to bowl when it is his/her turn may be credited with a zero for that frame based on the ruling of a tournament official.
11. Falsification of any information on the entry form is grounds for disqualification.
12. Rules: All Rules and regulations not specifically covered in these rules will be followed in accordance with current USBC Youth tournament rules.
